***EXECUTIVE SESSION***

***Pursuant to A.R.S. Section 38-431.03(A) (1), (2), (3,) (4), (5), (6) and (7). The Board may vote to convene in executive session to discuss or consider personnel matters, confidential records exempt by law from public inspection, and/or to consult with the Board's Attorney for legal advice to consider the Boards' position and to instruct the Boards' attorney regarding its position in contemplated litigation. The Boards will take action on items in open session.***

***Pursuant to A.R.S. 38-43101(H)*** A Fire District Board may make an open call to the public during a public meeting, subject to reasonable time, place and manner restrictions, to allow individuals to address the Fire District Board on any issue within the jurisdiction of the Fire District. At the conclusion of an open call to the public, individual members of the Fire District Board may respond to criticism made by those who have addressed the Fire District Board, may ask staff to review a matter or may ask that a matter be put on a future agenda. However, members of the Fire District Board shall not discuss or take legal action on matters raised during an open call to the public unless the matters are properly noticed for discussion and legal action.
