- a. Discussion and Possible Board Action to send Shop 066 to public auction.

Chief Zangle presented the plan to auction off the 2006 HME pumper at a public auction. The board asked questions about the details of the truck including the worth. The board asked staff to first get an appraisal from a apparatus firm before moving forward with it.

Motion to approve sending Shop 066 to public auction after staff obtains a certified appraisal from a credible apparatus appraisal firm and uses the value as a reserve price by Delene Mahoney. Seconded by Jonathan Maitem. There was no further discussion. Motion passed unanimously, 4-0.
